

# DAWN HRYCAK-POPOVIĆ

## VIOLIN

Dawn Hrycak-Popović is a native of Regina Saskatchewan. In 1993 she completed her bachelor of music degree under the late Bogdan Pietrzak at the University of Regina. After leaving Regina, she received a master of music degree in Performance and Literature from the University of Western Ontario under the late Lorand Fenyves.

Throughout her musical career, Ms. Hrycak-Popović has had the opportunity to play with many orchestras in North America and around the world. In 1993 she was the only North American violinist chosen to play with the Jeunesses Musicales World Orchestra for their two European tours. In the spring, 1996 she was concertmaster for the National Orchestral Institute (America), and served as concertmaster for the National Youth Orchestra's 1996 Japan tour and 1998 European tour. She has been a member of the Regina Symphony, and has played with Orchestra London.

In 1994 and 1995 Ms. Hrycak-Popović was a featured soloist with the National Repertory Orchestra in Colorado. She has also had solo performances with the University of Regina orchestra and Windsor Symphony Orchestra.

Dawn Hrycak-Popović holds a bachelor of social work from the University of Windsor and a master's degree in social work with a specialization in cognitive behavioral therapy from Wayne State University. When she is not playing with Windsor Symphony Orchestra, she is a health care case manager with the Erie St. Clair Community Care Access Centre (CCAC).
