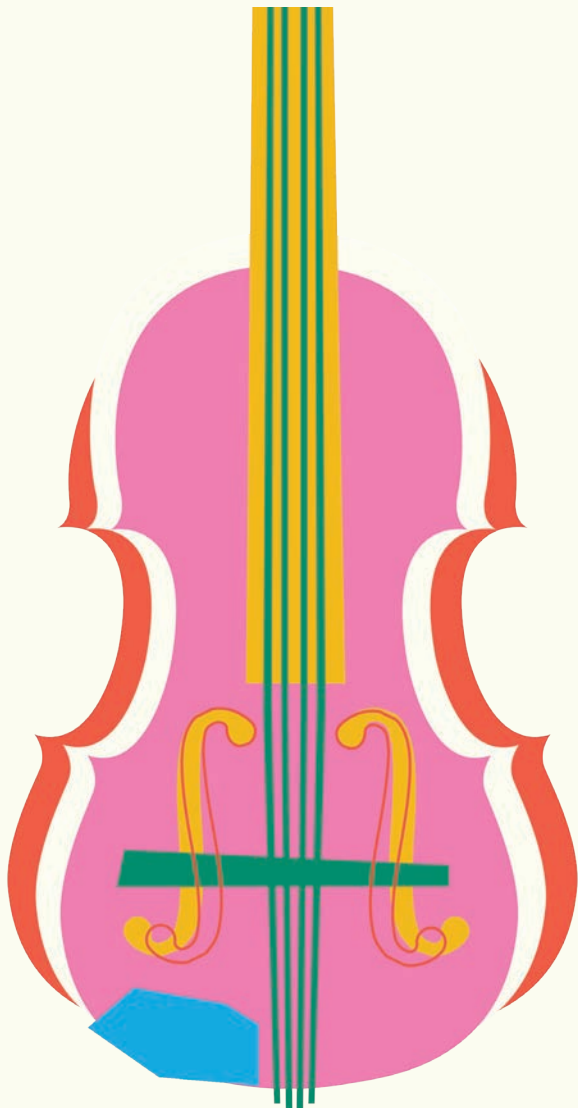

The Toldo Pops series kicks off with a foot-stomping good time as we welcome London, Ontario, native Genevieve Fisher for a fun concert of country music blended with the sounds of the orchestra.
